- BYOB BRING YOUR OWN BOTTLE (of water!)
 There is a plastic water bottle ban on at the Perth Kilt Run
 You can fill your own at The Perth Museum (just up from the starting line) and the Perth Arena (at Beckwith and Foster)
- Roads close at 5:30pm and open at 7:30pm.

 The Crystal Palace parking lot will be entirely closed for parking.
- 3) Kilt/bib/tee pick up is race day only. 2-5pm at the Crystal Palace. Bring a belt or thread if you think it is not going to fit.
- 4) Music/Shortbread Comp/Facepainting/Food Vendors/Scottish Society of Ottawa/Tee Sales/Maple Syrup Demo/Beer Gardens will all be held at the Crystal Palace
- 5) The amazing Haggis Toss (open to the public) will be held at its usual location Stewart Park (behind the town hall)
- 6) March to the Start begins at 5:45pm from Market Square (behind the town hall) and Mill St. (one block south of the town hall)

 Faster runners are asked to go to Mill St.; slower runners at Market Square
- 7) We ask all **Royal Mile Runners to move quickly** up to Harvey St. (about 400m). This will allow a smooth run for the 5 Milers who are coming rapidly behind you.
